Subject: Communication regarding Spain (Including Balearics and Canaries)

In response to recent travel restrictions announced by the Spanish Government and updated travel advice from the Irish Department of Foreign Affairs, we have cancelled all Aer Lingus flights between Ireland and Spain from 22 March to 30 April. Please review the table below as there is variables by route.
